GMI Missionaries to Tanzania:

Ted & Kim Rabenold



With 30 years of experience in different parts of Tanzania, Ted and Kim Rabenold have for the past number of years been serving in the remote Rukwa Region of SW Tanzania. APBC has many connections with our GMI field in Tanzania and have taken numerous mission trips there over the years. We were also the sending church of the Caraway family when they went to Tanzania.

When Ted & Kim moved to the Rukwa Valley, they began to establish Agricultural Training Centers for educating the subsistence and small-scale farmers living in their area. They brought in teachers to train both theory & practical aspects of farming vocations, such as horticulture, orchard management, environmental awareness and preservation, erosion control, animal husbandry, fish farming, beekeeping, as well as innovative and sustainable resource utilization. Our Awana kids gave toward a Fish Farm project 2 years ago.

Ted & Kim have spent their lives sharing the gospel of Christ and helping the Tanzanian people develop a healthy stewardship of the land and resources around them. They have been recognized by the President of Tanzania and governmental leaders for bringing the Rukwa Valley into national prominence for economic renewal.

Most importantly, they have been training Tanzanians in spiritual leadership and these national disciples are taking God's message of grace and hope to this region that until recently had been one of the last unreached people groups in the world.
