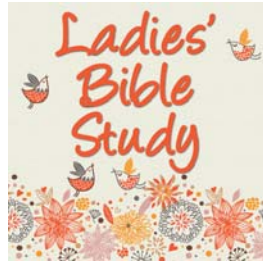


Men & Ladies Tuesday Night Bible Study Information!
