
Noted theologian and best-selling author, Dr. Timothy George helps to answer these and other questions in this visually rich 4 part series on DVD. The series avoids the angry condemnation of all Muslims on the one hand, or a compromising of Christian truthclaims on the other. Muslim views are stated fairly and objectively from Muslim scholars who appear in the series. You will find the basic and foundational differences between Christianity and Islam and the implication for how we understand God, Christ, and the meaning of salvation. Discussion will follow each DVD presentation.

Our topics will cover: 1) The Tenets of Islam; 2) The Trinity; 3) The Bible and the Incarnation; and 4) The Cross and Salvation.
