

"We practice Communion, with broken bread and grape juice, as a memorial of the broken body and shed blood of Christ upon the cross (I Cor.11:23-26). We believe that the bread and grape juice are symbolic and bring no special grace to those who ingest them. Instead, the Lord's Table serves us as time for remembering the price of our redemption; a time of worship and giving thanks to our Savior; for personal reflection and examination of our relationship with Christ; as a declaration of our faith; and as a reminder that He is coming again. While the Word of God contains virtually no instructions as to how Communion is to be celebrated, the Scriptures specifically command us to do so until Christ returns (I Cor.11:26)." 
