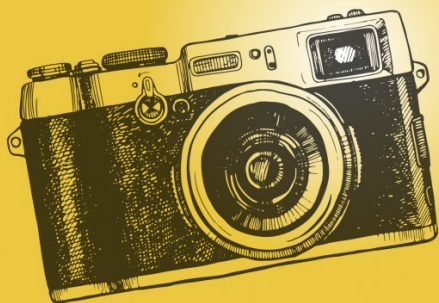

JAMES

James is the source of famous phrases and quotations that have made their way into Christian conversations for centuries, such as:

"If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God;" "God cannot be tempted with evil;" "Be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger;" "Be doers of the Word, and not hearers only;" "Faith apart from works is dead;" "Resist the devil and he will flee from you" ... and many more. The book has been called "The Proverbs of the New Testament."

But there are portions of James that have left Christians scratching their heads and many people stay away from the letter since he seems to contradict the Apostle Paul and the message of grace through faith alone.

There is an easy answer to the questions that are raised, and we will be exploring those differences between Law and Grace, vertical and horizontal truths, and interdispensational principles, but also zeroing in on the driving message inspired by the Holy Spirit to us as men to work out our faith in a life of obedience (cf. Phil. 2:12-13). That's James's focus, and as we study this epistle verse by verse and rightly divided, we will find stirring exhortations to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which we have been called. Join your fellow Anchormen in this new Bible Study as we ask the question of ourselves: **Do I have what it takes to become a mature**
